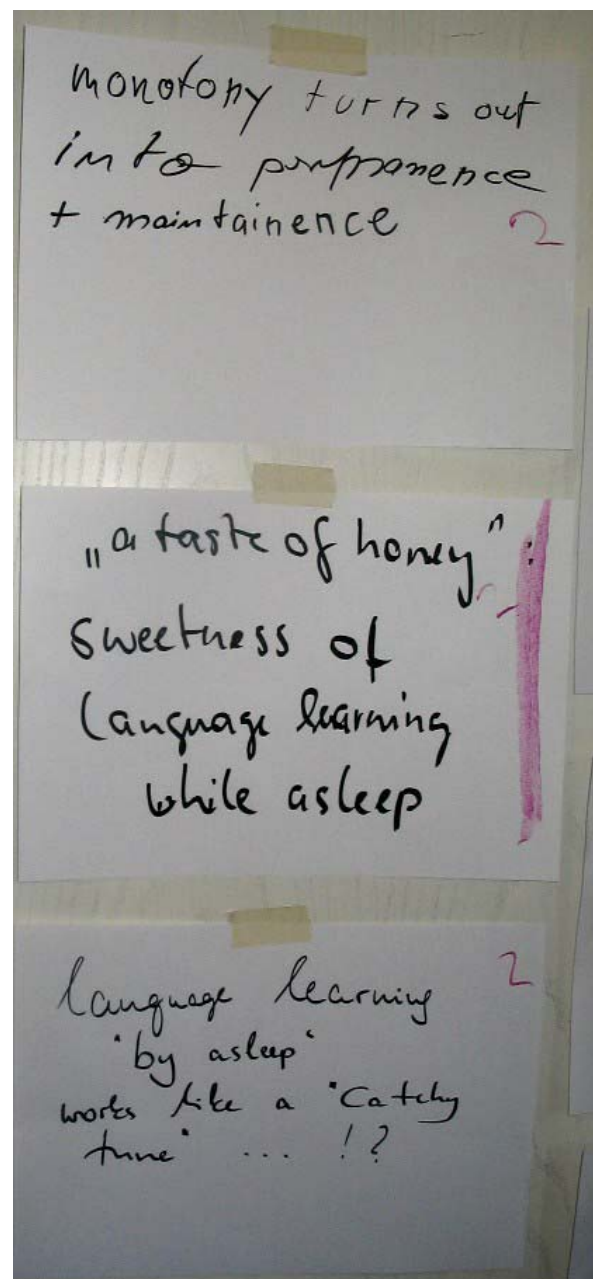

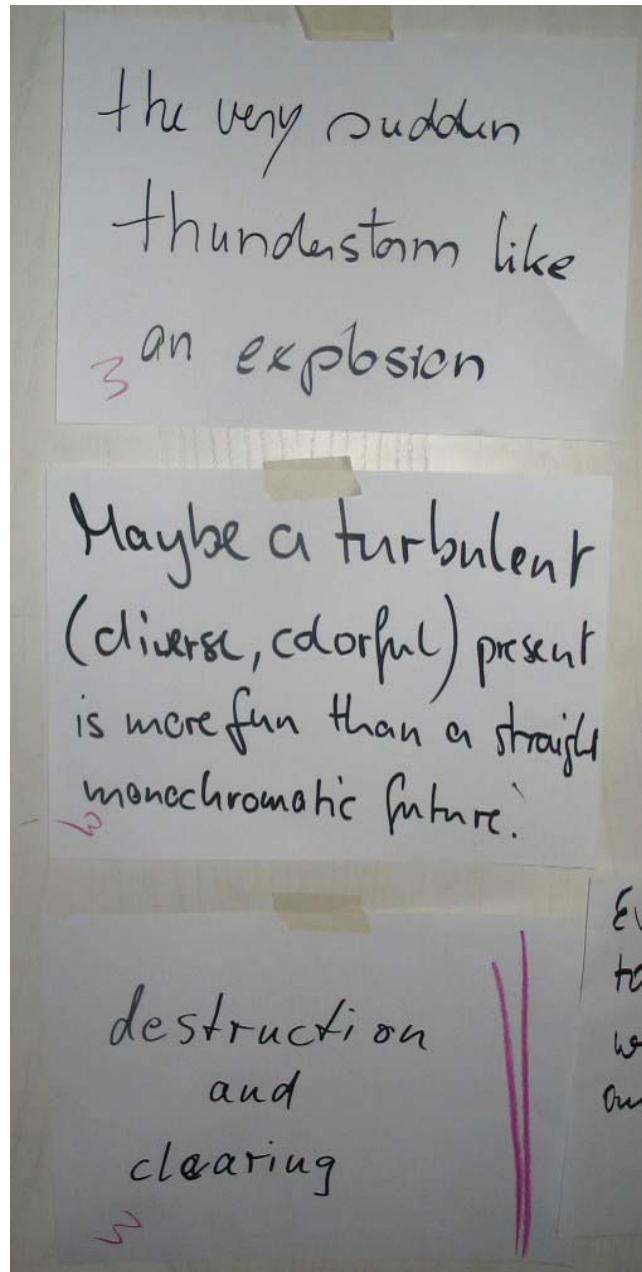

### 5 guidelines for the phase of Realisation + Practise:

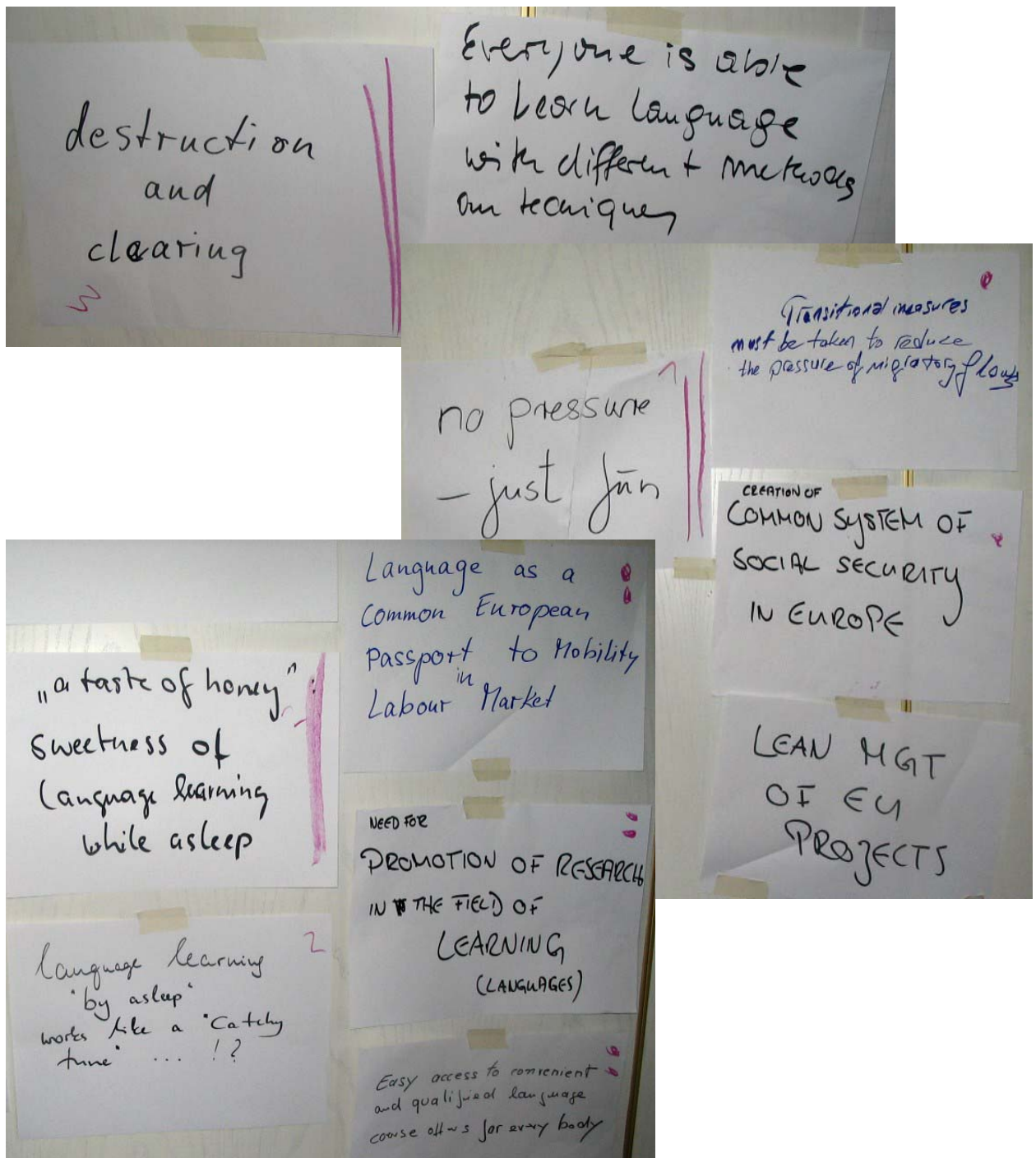
1. Plan realistically.

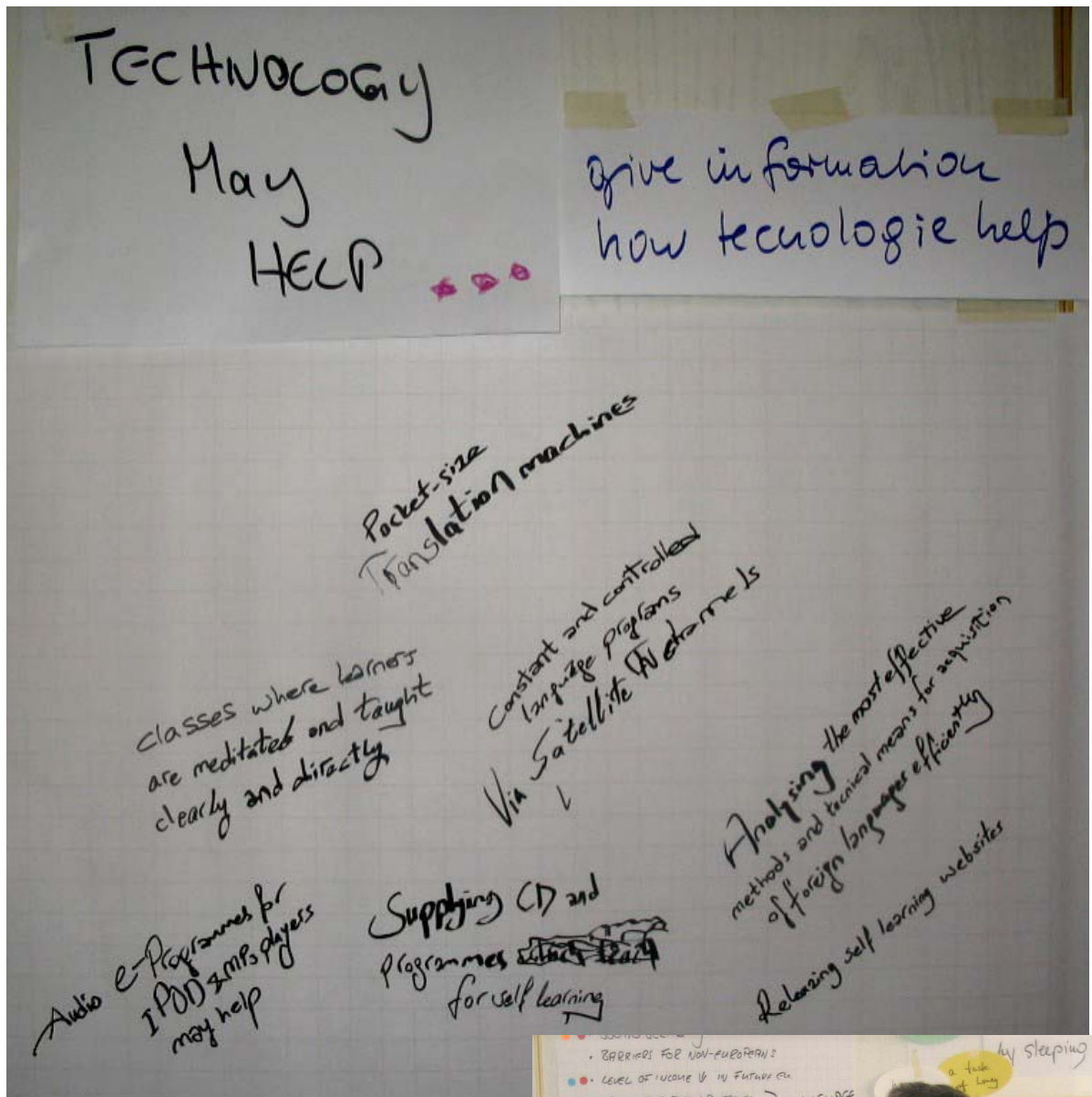


## Develop a course of action from the idea and outline goals, procedural basis, cooperation partners, resources and time-frame
